

“ The Temple Beautiful Revisited” March 7 -18, 2019

***FOR ALEXANDRIA OPTON: 2 EXTRA Nights
March 18 & 19. Book US Departure flight 3/20.**

DEPARTURE DATE March 7 – Departure From US
Fly from U.S. to Cairo. You will arrive in Cairo one day later than your departure date. European travelers arrive into Cairo the same day. Book your tickets accordingly. U.S. and Canadian citizens may obtain your Egyptian visa upon entry at Cairo airport (\$25 US cash only).

Day 1 - March 8 - Arrival in Cairo.

You will be met at the Cairo airport by our tour manager and escorted through customs, visa and baggage claim. Transfer to our Cairo hotel, Le Meridien HELIOPOLIS or similar. Overnight Cairo.

Day 2 - March 9 - Cairo – Museum

After breakfast, we visit the amazing Cairo Museum with its world famous archaeological treasures of 5,000 years of Egyptian history, including the golden mummy mask of King Tut and rare sculptures, jewelry and artifacts representing the height of Egypt's glory. We will visit one of the most famous shopping bazaars in Cairo. Overnight Cairo (B)

Day 3 – March 10 – Cairo – Luxor

We fly to Luxor and check into our hotel, our “Temple Beautiful” on the Nile, where we can relax with lunch by the pool or in the luxurious spa overlooking the water. (Tania may also be available for private healing sessions booked in advance), Late afternoon felucca ride to enjoy the sunset (weather permitting), or Luxor Temple by night. Dinner at our hotel. (B)

Day 4 - March 11 – Luxor

Full Day at Karnak Temple, the largest temple of ancient Egypt. We will visit “hidden” sanctuaries as Mary explains the mysteries of the Goddesses Sekmet and Hathor as practiced here over thousands of years. We will have entry to the Chapel Rouge outdoor museum dedicated to the female Pharaoh, Hatshepsut, as well as private time to meditate and fully explore this amazing temple at our leisure and in between the crowds. Overnight Luxor Hilton(B)

Day 5 – March 12 – Luxor West Bank

We cross the Nile to visit the West Bank for our “temple immersion day”. Morning is spent at Valley of the Kings including tombs of King Tut, Ramses, etc. Next, is the Temple of Hatshepsut (the first female Pharaoh), where we can now see the newly restored (first time open in 20 years) sanctuary of Amun. Leisurely afternoon Lunch on the West Bank. Later, we have the option to visit local alabaster factory, and a special “surprise” is planned before we return to our hotel. Overnight Luxor Hilton (B)

Day 6 – March 13 – Luxor-

Our second morning visit to the “off the beaten track” West Bank sites: Medinet Habu Temple (one of the best preserved temples in Egypt) & Valley of the Queens. Enjoy afternoon of integration at our Nile spa hotel; private sessions with Tania; lunch by the pool. Pre-dinner evening group meeting with Mary & Tania in preparation for our Dendera/Abydos Pilgrimage. Overnight Luxor Hilton. (B)

Day 7 – March 14 – Luxor- Abydos

Early morning departure for Abydos. After a scenic drive through the Egyptian countryside, we reach the Temple of Abydos, dedicated to the god, Osiris, and known as the “Resurrection Temple”. Group Meditation at the mysterious structure known as the Oseirion, which may date back to pre-Atlantean times. Lunch & dinner at the Flower Of Life Rest house in Abydos. Overnight Abydos. (B,L, D)

Day 8 – March 15 – Dendera-Luxor

Sunrise view over Abydos, then private time for meditation at the “hidden” Temple of Ramses II, After lunch, we continue on to Dendera Temple, the magnificent “House of Hathor, the goddess of love, music, aromatherapy, & astrology. Here Mary will explain the initiation of the Blue Lotus and the healing properties of this sacred flower. We will walk the ancient ceremonial staircases and celebrate our own “rebirthing” in the Chapel of the New Year and the “Birthing House of the Goddess Isis. We return back to Luxor this evening. Overnight Luxor. (B,L)

Day 9 – March 16 –Luxor –Giza

Today, we spend time at the greatest wonders of the world, the Pyramid of Giza and the Sphinx, including entry inside the Great Pyramid and the “ascension” to the King's Chamber. We will also visit the Sphinx, the ancient guardian of the pre-Atlantean “Hall of Records”, as described by Edgar Cayce. Afternoon free for shopping, spa services or relaxing poolside in front of the Great Pyramid. Overnight Le Meridien Giza. (B).

Day 10 –March 17- Giza –Saqqara

Our first stop is the city of Memphis, the first capital of ancient Egypt to view the newly opened museum dedicated to Ramses II. Then on to the incredible stepped pyramid of King Djoser, which was built by the famous architect, magician and healer, Imhotep. The Saqqara complex was considered by psychic Edgar Cayce to be the ancient site of the Atlantean Temple Beautiful in Egypt. We will lunch at the beautiful oasis-like setting of the Saqqara Palm Club. Optional afternoon visit to one of the local carpet schools where we see how the young people are taught the traditional silk weaving methods handed down for generations. Overnight Le Meridien. (B, L).
